Prompt: Write an informative essay that explains Malala Yousafzai's dilemma and her response to it. How did her response change her situation and affect the world? Use evidence from the book, *I am Malala*, to support your statements.

Write a five paragraph, informative essay. The introduction paragraph should have a hook and a thesis statement. Each body paragraph should be in the SWEET T.E.A. format. The conclusion paragraph should reflect on the overall point of view of Malala's purpose and a concluding statement.
